- **Air Conditioners**
- **Appliances** dehumidifiers, heat pumps, water heaters, microwaves, washers, dryers, refrigerators, etc.
- **Batteries** Auto and Household
- **Bicycles** *donated to a charity who cleans them up and distributes to those in need
- **Bulbs/Fluorescent Tubes, Ballasts, Light Fixtures** In original packaging or surrounded by cardboard. DO NOT tape together. Must be disassembled and ballasts disconnected from housing unit.
- **Carpet (Rolled)**
- **Construction Material/Debris/Junk** doors, lumber, fences, tile, sheetrock
- **Electronics**
- **Mattresses, Box Springs, Upholstered Furniture**
- **Propane Tanks**
- **Scrap Iron/Metal** ALL plastic removed; Tanks/Barrels must be cut in half.
- **Tires** with or without rims

NOT ALLOWED:

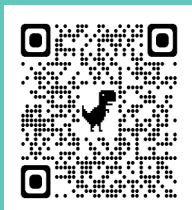
- **CONCRETE**

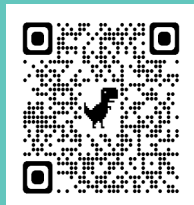

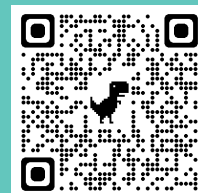
