Enclosed is our application to amend the CUP for the Zuhrah Shrine Horse Patrol d/b/a Horsemen, Inc. We have also included a photo of our land & facilities at 4505 County Road 92 North, Independence, MN. We have also included a letter and animal registration schedule from the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency, reflecting the number of animals (horses) at our facilities according to their most recent registration.

We moved into our new home in 1988 after building a 34 horse stable. In the mid 1990's we were struggling to maintain a 50% horse occupancy, so we decided to sell 7.40 acres and build an indoor riding arena to attract non-member boarders. In 2003, the City of Minneapolis began looking for a facility that could be a place to start a Police mounted unit. At that time, we had 3 or 4 of our members, employed by the Minneapolis Police, who were boarding their personnel horses at our facilities. Our mounted Patrol offered to loan the Police a few of our horses that had been in numerous parades over the years, being exposed to loud noises, crowds, drums, horns, motorcycles, flags, fireworks, etc.

When the Police Horse Unit grew to approximately 10 horses, they wanted a separate horse barn with 13 box stalls, plus storage for their equipment and grain. We reached an agreement with them for a multi-year horse boarding contract which included use of our indoor arena to annually train their new riding members. They also have use of our dining area and upstairs meeting room for classes during the annual training sessions.

We are requesting our CUP be amended to 80 horses. Our contract with the City of Minneapolis requires us to provide additional box stalls (3 or 4) if they have a need for additional horses. We have at least 80 acres available to our horses and the various veterinarians servicing our horses say we have the healthiest herd of horses in the Metropolitan area.


