Plastics Bottles & Jugs Plastics Cups & Containers Yogurt cups, pudding and fruit cups, clear disposable Water, soda and juice bottles, dish soap cups (no straws), margarine/whipped cream tubs, bottles, shampoo bottles, soap and cottage cheese and similar containers, clear produce, lotion bottles, and detergent jugs (empty and clean/rinse, and dry; caps on) deli and take-out containers (empty and rinse; lids on)

Boxes (Flattened)

Cardboard, cereal, cracker, pasta and tissue boxes, shoe, gift and electronic boxes, toothpaste and other toiletry boxes





Milk cartons, juice cartons, juice boxes, soup, broth and wine cartons (empty and clean/rinse, and dry; caps on)



Paper

Mail, office and school papers, magazines and catalogs, newspapers and inserts, phone books (clean; staples OK)



Metal Food and beverage cans (empty and rinse; labels OK)



Brown, green and clear bottles and jars (empty and rinse; no lids)
