Discussion:

There are several items that staff would like to discuss with the Council as follows:

The City recently completed an update to the Pioneer Creek Community Park Master Plan. Following completion of the master plan, the City worked to prepare an estimate of costs associated with the development of the park. The City looked at an overall development cost and then also individual amenity costs that were further broken down. Bas

The cost breakdown goes further into detail for each individual component. Some of the individual components are reliant on other components being developed simultaneously such as parking, etc. Staff has narrowed the scope so that we could potentially fund a Phase I project consisting of the following components:

- Two (2) multi-purpose fields (i.e., soccer, football, lacrosse, etc.).
- Four (4) pickleball courts.
- Relocation of the entrance drive to accommodate future softball/baseball fields.
- Approximately 55 parking spaces along entrance drive.
- Grading, utilities and landscaping associated with the development of the aforementioned items.

The estimated cost of developing the aforementioned components is \$1,015,000.00, plus soft costs. The City has targeted the Hennepin County Youth Sport Facility Grant program as one potential funding mechanism that could leverage a portion the City's funds to realize an initial development project. The City believes that it could obtain matching funding to construct the multi-purpose fields and associated site grading and parking lot serving the multi-purpose fields. The remainder of the site improvements would need to be further evaluated to understand actual costs.

The City currently has \$401,000 in its park fund that can be used to develop Pioneer Creek Park. The City would initially submit a grant application to Hennepin County seeking matching funding for the development of the multi-purpose fields and associated parking. The remaining site development and pickleball courts would not be eligible for grant funding. The maximum amount of the grant award has been reduced to \$300,000 for this round of funding. The City would submit a grant seeking \$280,000 to match the City's \$280,000 to fund the multi-purpose field development as follows:

Earthwork: \$137,000
 Drain Tile: \$24,000
 Parking/Drive: \$350,000
 Landscaping: \$49,000
 TOTAL \$560,000

Staff has also asked for supporting letters from Orono Youth Baseball and Softball Associations and Orono Westonka Youth Soccer. It is anticipated that these will be submitted with the grant application.

• Fire District Update:

The City met with WSFD to continue the discussion relating to a possible fire district. Staff has taken the updated information and is now working with ABDO to analyze the information and provide a comparison that looks at the difference in costs between contract fire services and a fire district. It is anticipated that following the preparation of this analysis, we will be able to meet with Maple Plain to further review and discuss. Chief McCoy and the City are in the process of setting up a meeting with the State Auditor's Office and representatives from PERA to discuss the MP Relief Associations options relating to a merger with WSFD. Staff will review the current process with Council.

• November Meeting Schedule:

The City Council has moved the November 7th CC Meeting to Monday, November 6th. The second November CC Meeting falls on Thanksgiving week (Tuesday prior to Thanksgiving). Staff would like to know if it may be more efficient to meet on Tuesday, November 14th (typically off week) and cancel both the November 6th and November 21st CC Meetings. At this time, the City would not have any conflicts with holding one meeting in November. In addition, staff would like to discuss potential joint meeting dates that could be used for a meeting with Maple Plain at the end of October or in November.

Council Recommendation:

Staff is seeking direction relating to the issues presented. City Council is being asked to consider approving *RESOLUTION No. 2023-1012-01* approving the submittal of a grant application to Hennepin County for the Hennepin County Youth Sports Facility Grant. The grant application is due on October 17th 2023.

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE HENNEPIN COUNTY, MINNESOTA

RESOLUTION NO. 23-1012-01

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION TO HENNEPIN COUNTY FOR THE HENNEPIN YOUTH ACTIVITIES GRANT – FACILITY GRANT

WHEREAS, the Hennepin County Board of Commissioners, via the Hennepin Youth Activities Grants, provides for capital funds to assist local government units of Hennepin County for the development of sports or recreational facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Independence (hereinafter LGU) desires to develop Pioneer Creek Community Park (hereinafter PROJECT).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE City Council of the LGU:

- I. The estimate of the total cost of developing PROJECT shall be \$680,000. The LGU is requesting \$280,000 from the Hennepin Youth Activities Grants program and will assume responsibility for providing matching funds of \$280,000.
- II. City of Independence is the owner of the property where the PROJECT is located. City of Independence will own the property where PROJECT is located for at least the functional life of the facility, which is estimated to be 100 years. The PROJECT may not be converted to a non-public or non-recreational uses within this time period without the approval of Hennepin County.
- III. City of Independence agrees to assume one hundred (100) percent of operational and maintenance costs for PROJECT. City of Independence will operate PROJECT for its intended purpose as stated in the PROJECT application for the functional life of the facility.
- IV. LGU agrees to enter into necessary and required agreements with Hennepin County for the specific purpose of developing PROJECT and managing its long-term operation.
- V. That the City Administrator and Mayor are authorized and directed to execute the application for the Hennepin Youth Activities Grants program. CERTIFICATION I hereby certify that the foregoing resolution is a true and correct copy of the resolution presented to and adopted by the City Council at a duly authorized meeting thereof held on the 12th day of October 2023, as shown by the minutes of said meeting in my possession.

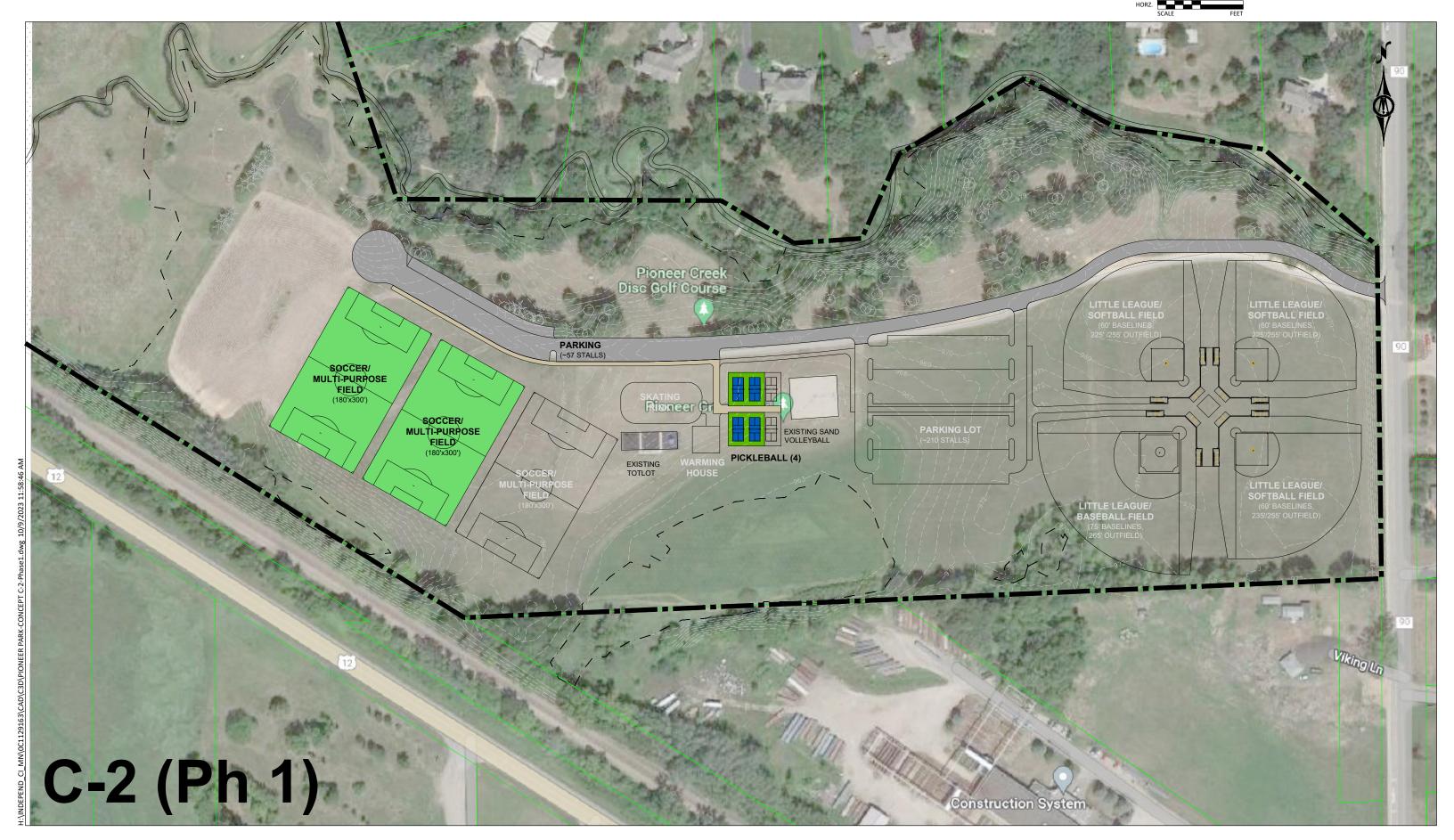
