## 4. <u>CANVASS ELECTION RESULTS</u>

Johnson reported they must canvass the results of the election.

The election results were:

### Office of Mayor

- Marvin Johnson- Write-ins44 votes

Results show that incumbent Marvin Johnson was voted back in to serve another 4-year term starting January 1, 2012 and running through December 31, 2015.

#### Office of Councilmember

-Brad Fisher 640 votes -Norm Wenck 572 votes -Write-ins 20 votes

Results show that incumbent Norm Wenck, person at large, was voted back in to serve another 4-year term and Brad Fisher, person at large was voted in to also serve a 4-year term starting January 1, 2012 and running through December 31, 2015.

Total registered voters at 7:00 a.m. were 2,446. We had 24 new registered voters during the course of the day, with a total of 854 voters in all (Approximately 35%).

Motion by Betts, seconded by Wenck, to approve the election results from the November 8, 2011 election. Ayes: Betts, Johnson, Spencer, Wallace and Wenck. Nays: None. Absent: None. MOTION DECLARED CARRIED.
